## The Current Situation

While there is great unrest in the south of Haiti, the northern part of the country remains relatively calm at present - although that can change. Bill & Sandy are in Haiti and doing well. Our schools are in session and our workers and teachers are all coming to work. But in anticipation of supply line interruptions in the south, Bill did have to pay \$13 USD per gallon for gas this week.

The container with the new high school building and lots of missionary supplies has arrived in port at Cap Haitien. Christian is hoping to have it released from the port and on our compound this week.

By God's grace and your prayers we did manage to have a great week with a medical team that came in February (*see next page*). But just to be safe, we did cancel two teams scheduled for March. Hopefully they can reschedule soon. And pray that our Campus Life Week revival and evangelism team can come in May as planned to preach to our school children.

Bill & Sandy and the ministry are doing OK at present. However, if the political unrest continues to escalate without resolution, the whole country will be sorely affected. Supply lines will be cut off. The ports and airports will close. And basic needs such as food and fuel will quickly be in short supply. Naturally, should things continue to move in this direction, the unrest will intensify, and Bill & Sandy will be in a difficult situation. Please be in constant prayer for GSM.



## Biclaire High School Project

In February we loaded all the components for our new 35' x 80' Biclaire High School building onto a container in Alabama. The container, loaded with the building and many mission supplies, made it safely to port in Cap Haitien. Now Christian is working to clear everything through customs. Hopefully we will get it onto our compound this week. Pray for Christian.
